



**CallWave Demonstrates Mobile Video Collaboration for BlackBerry Bold
at Interop New York and Web 2.0 Expo**

*New FUZE Service Enables Mobile Real-time Collaboration
with Synchronization of Media and Video for New Device*

NEW YORK AND SAN FRANCISCO – September 16, 2008 – CallWave, Inc. "FUZE in itself is a powerful tool for collaboration and conferencing," said Jeff Cavins, chief executive officer of CallWave. "Being able to do everything you need in real-time from your BlackBerry or other device takes it to the next level, enabling mobile professionals to truly collaborate from anywhere at any time with anyone in the world."

in New York City on September 17-18. Demonstrations will take place in booth number 1112 at Interop and 1516 at Web 2.0.
